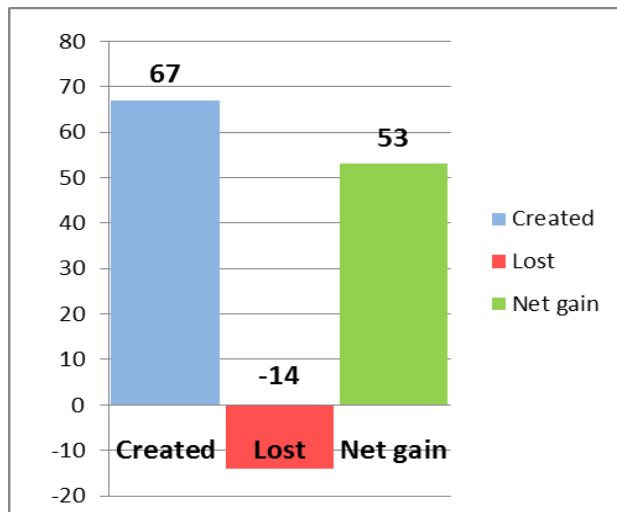
## Results from April's Grand Erie Employer Survey

The Workforce Planning Board thanks the 63 employers who participated in our monthly survey regarding their workforce. The survey regarding June's employment will be distributed on June 6. Here are highlights from the survey for April.

Thirty-five per cent of the employers who participated were from the Manufacturing Sector, 17% from Health Care/Social Assistance, 11% from Retail, and 13% from the Other Services Sector (excluding public administration).

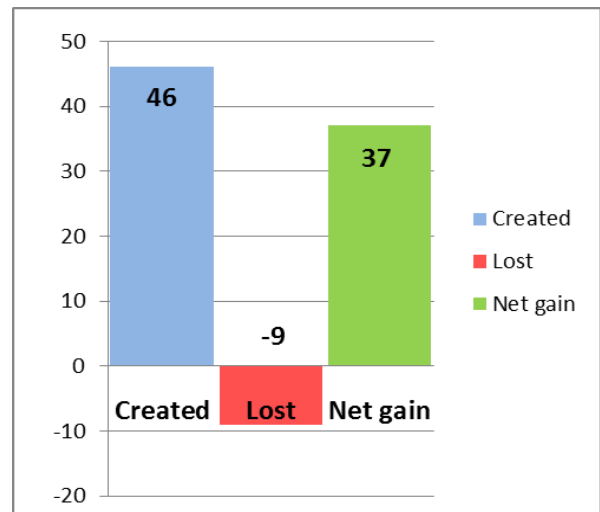
Of the 63 employers who participated, 63% indicated their employment remained the same, while the remaining 37% increased or decreased staff. Twenty employers added staff, while six decreased their numbers.

### Overall Jobs Gained/Lost



The total number of positions added, both full and part-time, was 67, while the number of positions lost was -14, for a net gain of 53 jobs.

### Manufacturing Jobs Gained/Lost



The number of manufacturing positions added, both full and part-time, was 46, while -9 jobs were lost, for a net gain of 37 jobs.
