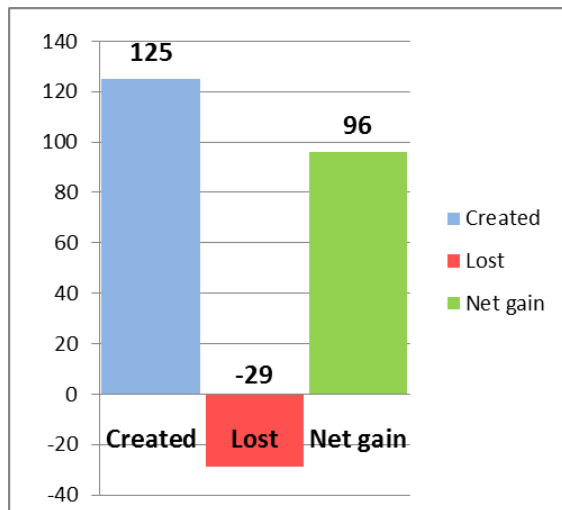
Results from May's Grand Erie Employer Survey

The Workforce Planning Board thanks the 92 employers who participated in our monthly survey regarding their workforce. The survey regarding June's employment will be distributed on July 5. Here are highlights from the survey for May

Thirty-nine per cent of the employers who participated were from the Manufacturing Sector, 9% from Health Care/Social Services and 13% from the Other Services Sector (excluding public administration).

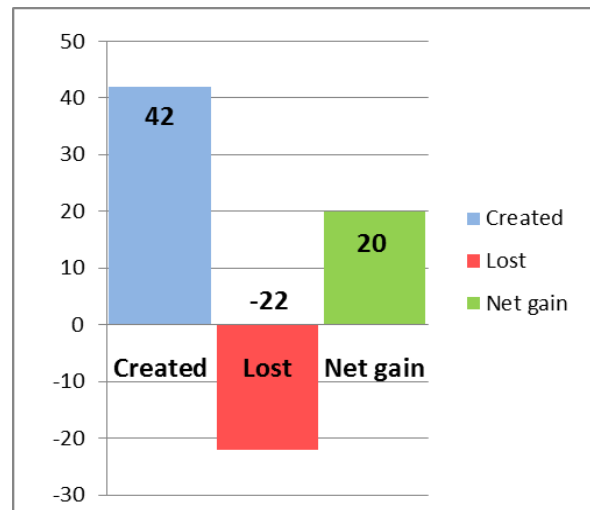
Of the 92 employers who participated, 68% indicated their employment remained the same, while the remaining 32% increased or decreased staff. Twenty-nine employers added staff, while nine decreased their numbers.

Overall Jobs Gained/Lost



The total number of positions added, both full and part-time, was 125, while the number of positions lost was -29, for a net gain of 96 jobs.

Manufacturing Jobs Gained/Lost



The number of manufacturing positions added, both full and part-time, was 42, while 22 jobs were lost, for a net gain of 20 jobs. **Note:** Includes 17 jobs lost at one company.
