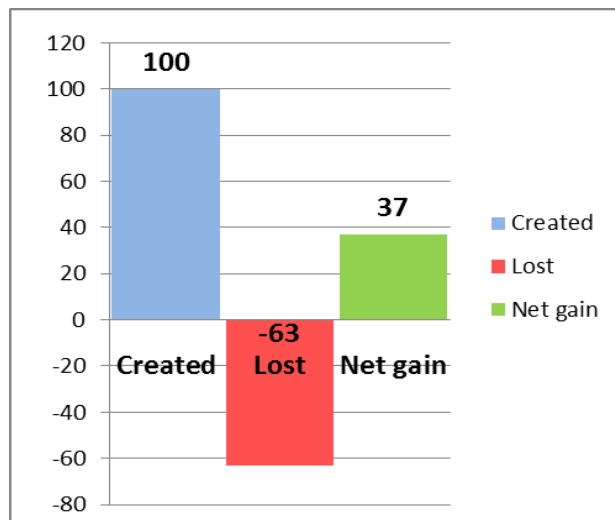
Results from July's Grand Erie Employer Survey

The Workforce Planning Board thanks the 82 employers who participated in our monthly survey regarding their workforce. The survey regarding August's employment will be distributed on Sept. 7. Here are highlights from the survey for July

Thirty-nine per cent of the employers who participated were from the Manufacturing Sector and 13% from Other Services (excluding public administration) and 10% from Health Care/Social Services.

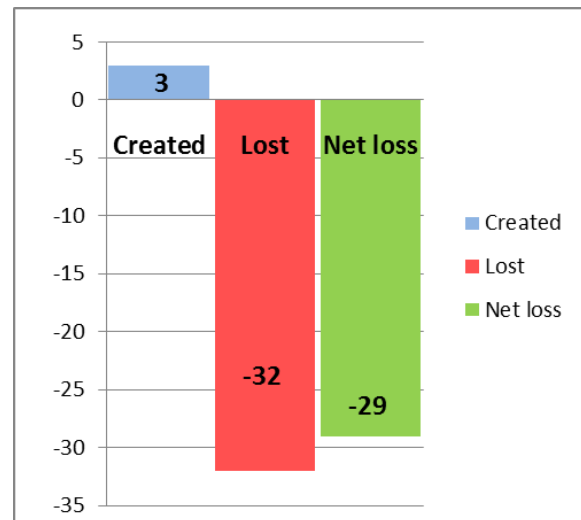
Of the 82 employers who participated, 74% indicated their employment remained the same, while the remaining 26% increased or decreased staff. Twelve employers added staff, while 15 decreased their numbers.

Overall Jobs Gained/Lost



The total number of positions added, both full and part-time, was 100, while the number of positions lost was -63, for a net gain of 37 jobs.

Manufacturing Jobs Gained/Lost



The number of manufacturing positions added, both full and part-time, was 3, while -32 jobs were lost, for a net loss of -29 jobs. Note: 28 jobs were lost at one company.
